## **About the Company**

Ice Theatre of New York, Inc. is the United States' first artistic skating ensemble. Its many programs provide an environment where professional skaters from various backgrounds can collaborate with dance choreographers, musicians, writers and visual artists to prepare and perform new skating pieces.

The company has performed and conducted classes throughout the United States, Canada and abroad. Along with new works by Artistic Director Rob McBrien and Founder/Director Moira North, the company has commissioned works by modern dance choreographers Ann Carlson, Laura Dean, Matthew Nash and William Whitener. To complement its vanguard ensemble work, the company regularly features such figure skating notables as Gary Beacom, Toller Cranston, Maia Usova and Alexandre Zhulin.

Ice Theatre's unique educational programs include on- and off-ice workshops that stress strong skating technique, theatricality and ensemble skating, an Apprentice Program and the Skating Program at the Professional Performing Arts School. Ice Theatre is enjoying increased acclaim for its efforts in developing ice skating as a performing art and expanding the possibilities of the discipline.
